Sec. 1. School Admimistrative District No. 62 exempted from adjustment for error in school subsidy payment. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Education may not reduce the State's share of current or future school subsidy payments to School Administrative District No. 62 to adjust for overpayment of subsidy due to the district's submission of erroneous pupil counts for the fiscal years 1987-88, 1988-89 and 1989-90.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve prohibits the Commissioner of Education from reducing school subsidy payments to School Administrative District No. 62 to adjust for overpayment of subsidy resulting from the submission of mistakenly high pupil counts by the district for the fiscal years 1987-88, 1988-89 and 1989-90. need for cross-reference, stylistic and other technical amendments to conform existing lam to current drafting standards.
