28	The county jail system may realize some savings from the elimination of this Class D crime, since sentences imposed for
30	Class D offenses must be served in a county jail. The average cost per sentence for a Class D crime is \$8,320 based upon an
32	average length of stay of 119 days.
34	The Judicial Department may realize some minor savings from reductions of workload and administrative costs associated with
