18	STATEMENT OF FACT
20	The purpose of this bill is to make allocations from the gross revenues of the Maine Turnpike Authority from the
22	authority's fiscal year ending December 31, 1995, in accordance with the requirements of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 23,
24	section 1961, subsection 6 and the authority's general bond resolution. The bill also clarifies the timing of submissions of
26	the authority's operating budgets.
