This amendment replaces the bill.		
The amendment creates a new license fee category for solid		
waste incinerators that are owned and operated by a municipality and that have a licensed capacity of 10 tons per day or less.		
The amendment applies this new category retroactively to		
July 1, 1993, the date of the most recent fee schedule changes adopted by the Board of Environmental Protection.
