34	The office of the Public Advocate will incur additiona annual payroll expenses, retirement costs and other benefit costs estimated to be \$18,000 to \$20,000 due to the redesignatio
36	of 4 employees as confidential, unclassified. The office of th Public Advocate will not require an allocation of funds in fisca
38	year 1994-95 to support these additional costs.
40	The office of the Public Advocate will also be permitted without further legislative approval, to carry forward fro
42	unexpended balances an additional 3% of the total annua assessment.'
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48	STATEMENT OF FACT
50	This amendment, which is the majority report of the Join Standing Committee on Utilities, changes the retroactive application of the Act to June 30, 1994. The amendment also add
