Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 38 MRSA $\S 363-\mathbb{D}$ is enacted to read:
\$363-D. Waiver or modification of protection and improvement
laws

The commissioner or the commissioner's designee may waive or modify any of the provisions of this chapter if that waiver or modification promotes or assists any oil spill response activity conducted in accordance with the national contingency plan, a federal contingency plan, the state marine oil spill contingency plan, or as otherwise directed by the federal on-scene coordinator, the commissioner or commissioner's designee.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill authorizes the Commissioner of Environmental Protection to waive or modify the requirements of the State's water protection and improvement laws when such waiver or modification is necessary to facilitate oil spill response activity.

This document has not yet been reviewed to determine the need for cross-reference, stylistic and other technical amendments to conform existing law to current drafting standards.
