8	The commissioner or the commissioner's designee may waive or modify any of the provisions of this chapter if that waiver or
10	modification promotes or assists any oil spill response activity conducted in accordance with the national contingency plan, a
12	federal contingency plan, the state marine oil spill contingency plan, or as otherwise directed by the federal on-scene
14	coordinator, the commissioner or commissioner's designee.
16	STATEMENT OF FACT

20	This bill authorizes the Commissioner of Environmental Protection to waive or modify the requirements of the State's water protection and improvement laws when such waiver or
22	modification is necessary to facilitate oil spill response activity.
