HOUSE AMENDMENT "H" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 696, L.D. 1894, Bill, "An Act to Authorize a General Fund Bond Issue in the Amount of $\$ 20,000,000$ for the Remediation and Closure of Municipal Solid Waste Landfills"<br>Amend the amendment by striking out the $3 r d$ and 4 th indented paragraphs before the fiscal note (page 2, lines 19 to 28 in amendment)<br>Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

- FISCAL NOTE

The estimated cost of sending this bond issue out to referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda enacted during the Second Regular Session of the 116th Legislature for submission to the voters at the November 1994 general election. The estimatea cost to the Secretary of State if one to 6 referenda are enacted is $\$ 95,000$. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$7,000.

If approved by the voters, the total cost of this bond issue is estimated to be $\$ 25,060,000$ with principal payments of $\$ 20,000,000$ and interest payments of approximately $\$ 5,060,000 .{ }^{\prime}$
