Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

Whereas, certain obligations and expenses will become due and payable on or immediately after July 1, 1994; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

#### PART A

Sec. A-1. Allocation. The following funds are allocated from the Highway Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1995 to carry out the purposes of this Part.

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2 Provides for the allocation for the

24           **"SECRETARY OF STATE, DEPARTMENT OF THE," in the last part**  
26           **relating to "Administration - Motor Vehicles" first to last lines are**  
              **repealed.**

28           **Sec. C-2. Nonlapsing.** Notwithstanding the Maine Revised  
30           Statutes, Title 5, section 1589 or any other provision of law,  
32           any unencumbered Personal Services balances of Highway Fund  
34           allocations in the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of State  
              Police account at the end of fiscal year 1993-94 may not lapse  
              but must be carried forward until June 30, 1995 and must be used  
              to conduct the Maine State Police training academy.

36           **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the  
38           preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.
