Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §7235 is enacted to read:

§7235. Railroad crossings for the purpose of timber harvesting

Upon the request of a timber harvester, a railroad corporation shall permit the erection of a railroad crossing for the sole purpose of accommodating timber harvesting operations. The timber harvester is liable only for maintaining the railroad crossing and may not be required to obtain insurance in excess of that associated with maintenance of the railroad crossing.

STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This bill requires that railroad corporations permit the erection of railroad crossings for the sole purpose of accommodating timber harvesting operations.
