
SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 724, L.D. 1945, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Public Smoking Laws"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in paragraph N in the 2nd line (page 1, line 29 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "hall" the following: ', bowling alley'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in paragraph N in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 32 and 33 in amendment) by striking out the following: "if minors are prohibited from that enclosed area at all times"

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment expands the exception to smoking laws granted in Committee Amendment "A" to bowling alleys and removes language prohibiting minors from the area in which smoking is allowed.
