- 4. Equipment and property transferred. All equipment and property of the former Department of Human Services, Bureau of Rehabilitation must be transferred to the Department of Education, Office of Rehabilitation Services, unless the Commissioner of Human Services and the Commissioner of Education jointly authorize a different policy.
- 5. Personnel transferred. Employees the 12 Department of Human Services, Bureau of Rehabilitation whose positions are transferred to the Department of Education, Office of Rehabilitation Services under this Act retain their positions 14 within the Office of Rehabilitation Services and their employee rights, privileges and benefits, including sick leave and 16 vacation. The Bureau of Human Resources within the Department of Administrative and Financial Services shall assist with the 18 orderly implementation of this section.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment corrects a technical error and provides provisions for the orderly transfer of the Department of Human Services, Bureau of Rehabilitation to the Department of Education, Office of Rehabilitation Services.
