HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 780, L.D. 2010, Bill, "An Act Relating to the Definition of Passamaquoddy Indian Territory"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 1 in paragraph B in the last 2 lines (page 2, lines 17 and 18 in amendment) by striking out the following: ", and any lands in Albany Township acquired by the Passamaquoddy Tribe before January 1, 1991" and inserting in its place the following: ', and ~~any lands in Albany Township acquired by the Passamaquoddy Tribe before January 1, 1991~~'

Further amend the amendment by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

**'Sec. 2. Land removed from trust.** Land located in Albany Township in Oxford County acquired by the secretary for the benefit of the Passamaquoddy Tribe pursuant to Public Law 1991, chapter 720 ceases to constitute a portion of Passamaquoddy Tribe territory and reverts to its former status prior to inclusion within the Passamaquoddy Tribe territory.


Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes from a trust for the Passamaquoddy Tribe certain land located in Albany Township in Oxford County previously placed in the trust.
