HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 780, L.D. 2010, Bill, "An Act Relating to the Definition of Passamaquoddy Indian Territory"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph B in the 7th and 8th lines from the end (page 1, lines 39 and 40 in L.D.) by striking out the following: ", and any lands in Albany Township acquired by the Passamaquoddy Tribe before January 1, 1991" and inserting in its place the following: '~~,--and--any--lands--in--Albany--Township--acquired--by--the--Passamaquoddy--Tribe--before--January--1,--1991~~'

Further amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Land removed from trust. Land located in Albany Township in Oxford County acquired by the secretary for the benefit of the Passamaquoddy Tribe pursuant to Public Law 1991, chapter 720 ceases to constitute a portion of Passamaquoddy Tribe territory and reverts to its former status prior to inclusion within the Passamaquoddy Tribe territory.'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.


HOUSE AMENDMENT
