HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 11, "Joint Order Adopting the
116th Joint Rules"

Amend Joint Rule 13 by striking out all of that part
entitled "Membership." and inserting in its place the following:

'Membership. Each of these committees shall consist of no
more than 3 on the part of the Senate and no more than 10 on the
part of the House. Minority leaders of both houses shall appoint
the minority members to their committee assignments on the
proportional basis reflecting the membership of the body.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment amends the joint rules by giving the minority
leaders authority to appoint minority members to their committees.
