COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 95, L.D. 235

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

The additional costs to provide electronic access to the 8 budget management system to the Office of Fiscal and Program Review for computer programming, wiring and software purchases can be absorbed by the Department of Administrative and Financial 10 Services and the Legislature utilizing existing budgeted 12 resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment further clarifies the aspects of the budget 18 management system to which the Office of Fiscal and Program Review would be given access. It also provides the electronic 20 transfer of enacted budget bills back to the Bureau of the Budget. Lastly, this amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
