K. Smoking is not prohibited in a public places place when a beano or bingo games--are game is being conducted in accordance with the provisions of Title 17, sections 314 and 314-A, except that the legislative body of a municipality may prohibit smoking in a public place that is under the jurisdiction of that legislative body when a beano or a bingo game is being conducted if that public place is used by persons who have not attained 18 years of age.

This bill allows the legislative body of a municipality to prohibit smoking in a public place under the control of the legislative body when a beano or a bingo game is being played if that public place is used by minors who have not attained 18 years of age.
