Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1542, sub-§2, ¶K, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 342, §1 and affected by §9, is amended to read:

K. Smoking is not prohibited in a public places place when a beano or bingo games—are game is being conducted in accordance with the provisions of Title 17, sections 314 and 314-A, except that the legislative body of a municipality may prohibit smoking in a public place that is under the jurisdiction of that legislative body when a beano or a bingo game is being conducted if that public place is used by persons who have not attained 18 years of age.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows the legislative body of a municipality to prohibit smoking in a public place under the control of the legislative body when a beano or a bingo game is being played if that public place is used by minors who have not attained 18 years of age.
