COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 106, L.D. 282, Bill, "An Act to Continue the Health Occupations Training Project"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

1996-97

LABOR, DEPARTMENT OF

Job Training Partnership Program

All Other \$200,000

Provides for the appropriation of funds to continue the Health Occupations Training Project.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

4 The Health Occupations Training Project, which is funded
6 through appropriations to the Department of Labor, will require
 additional General Fund appropriations of \$200,000 annually
 beginning in fiscal year 1996-97 for continuation of the program.

10 The Governor's proposed current services budget includes
12 \$200,000 in fiscal years 1995-96 and 1996-97, respectively, for
 the Health Occupations Training Project. The \$200,000 in fiscal
 year 1996-97 should not have been included as a current services
 appropriation due to the October 1, 1995 repeal date of the
 project.'
