24	Amend the resolution by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

28	'FISCAL NOTE
30	The estimated cost of sending this resolution out to
32	referendum will vary according to the total number of referenda enacted during the First Regular Session of the 117th Legislature. The estimated cost to the Secretary of State if one
34	to 6 referenda are enacted is \$95,000. Each additional referendum costs an additional \$7,000.
36	If approved by the voters, the Legislature would realize
38	General Fund savings beginning in fiscal year 2004-05. These savings, resulting from reductions of Legislators' salaries and
40	benefits, travel and constituent allowances and legislative staff, would be approximately \$970,000 for a first regular
42	session and \$670,000 for a second regular session.'
