§6954-B. Drag limits in South Bay in Eastport

It is unlawful to fish in South Bay in Eastport, including all waters south and east of a line drawn from Gove Point westerly to Youngs Point, with any one combination of drags or drag in excess of 5 feet 6 inches in width by measuring from the extreme outside edge of the mouth of the drag or drags. In addition, any rock drag used for the taking of scallops is limited to no more than 6 3-inch rings deep.
