HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 609, L.D. 819, Bill, "An Act to Require Notification to the Landowner When Land Is Being Considered for Placement in a Resource Protection Zone"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the amendment by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.'

This amendment strikes the section of Committee Amendment "A" that changes the process for giving notice of zoning ordinances affecting commercial, industrial and retail zones.
