

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §438-A, sub-§1-B** is enacted to read:

6 1-B. Notification to landowners. The board shall adopt
8 rules to provide for a written notification to a landowner whose
10 property is being considered for placement in a resource
12 protection zone. The notification must be by certified mail
14 within 60 days of the recommendation to place the property within
16 the resource protection zone.

12 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

14 This bill requires that the Board of Environmental
16 Protection must adopt rules providing for written notification to
18 a landowner whose property is being considered for placement in a
resource protection zone.
