24	estimates adopted by the Legislature and Governor, 50%'
26	FISCAL NOTE
28	This amendment reduces the amount to be transferred into the Reserve Fund from 75% to 50% of year-end excess General Fund
30	revenues.
32	SUMMARY
34	This amendment reduces the amount to be transferred to the constitutionally protected Reserve Fund at the end of each fiscal
36	year from 75% to 50% of excess General Fund revenues. It also changes the term "accepted General Fund revenue estimates" to
38 .	"General Fund revenue estimates" adopted by the Legislature and Governor.
