	STATEMENT OF FACT

	On January 1, 1995, new federal regulations mandated that
16	all commercial vehicle drivers be tested for drug and alcohol use
	abuse. These new regulations apply to interstate and intrastate
18	drivers.
20	This bill requires that Maine drivers and motor carriers
	follow the same federal rules as all other drivers and motor
22	carriers, instead of the standards required by the State.
