Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

8 The Department of Education will incur some minor additional costs to establish a study committee to review school budget 10 voting procedures and to participate in that review. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted 12 resources.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The bill would have restricted the use of the referendum method for adopting a school budget in a school administrative district to 3 referenda. If a final budget was not adopted after the 3rd referendum, the previous year's operating budget would have become the approved budget.

This amendment is the majority report and replaces the bill. The amendment directs the Commissioner of Education to establish a study committee to review the status statewide of the referendum method of adopting a school budget. The study committee must consist of representatives of a wide variety of interested groups and organizations. The committee shall present any recommendations to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education and cultural affairs by December 15, 1996.
