36	Insurance will incur some minor additional costs to determine the assessment redistribution. These costs can be absorbed within
38	the agencies' existing budgeted resources.
40	This redistribution will increase the assessments paid by
42	the State. The increased workers' compensation costs paid by state departments and agencies will not be significant and can be
