An Act to Extend the Period of Time an Operator May Operate a Motor Vehicle with a Temporary Registration Plate.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §462, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683,
4 Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

6 **2. Payment of fee for temporary registration plate.** The
7 fee for a temporary registration plate is \$1 per plate. A
8 purchaser may operate the motor vehicle or trailer with a
9 temporary registration plate for a period of 14 30 consecutive
10 days without payment of a regular fee. If the purchaser is a
11 nonresident member of the Armed Services, the purchaser may
12 operate a motor vehicle or trailer for a period of 20 consecutive
13 days without payment of a regular fee. At the end of this
14 initial period, a resident who is unable to comply with the
15 requirements of chapter 7 or a nonresident who has applied for
16 but has not yet received a registration certificate from a home
17 state may request the Secretary of State to extend this period
18 without charge for an additional 20 days.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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23 This bill increases from 14 to 30 the number of days a
24 person may operate a motor vehicle or trailer with a temporary
25 registration plate.

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
