
HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 769, L.D. 1882, Bill, "An Act to Create the Maine Health Care Reform Act of 1996"

Amend the bill in Part A in section 3 in that part designated "~~§1954.~~" in subsection 2 by striking out all of paragraph B (page 3, lines 28 to 33 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'B. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Title or Title 24, the alliance shall offer at least one health plan providing catastrophic coverage that contains an annual deductible of \$5,000 per covered family or \$3,000 per covered individual in accordance with rules developed by the superintendent.'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires a private purchasing alliance, as established in the bill, to offer a health plan providing catastrophic coverage.
