SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1374, L.D. 1883, "Resolve, for Laying of the County Taxes and Authorizing Expenditures of Androscoggin County for the Year 1996"

Amend the resolve in section 3 by inserting after that part designated "Total Appropriations" (page 4, line 1 in L.D.) the following:

'Overlay 19,742'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE


The increase of the county tax assessment by \$120,395 for municipalities in Androscoggin County represents a state mandate and would require 90% funding by the State pursuant to the Constitution of Maine. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the two thirds vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local costs.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a line that was inadvertently omitted from the resolve and adds a fiscal note to the resolve.
