HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 10, "Joint Order to Adopt Joint Rules"

Amend the Joint Order in Joint Rule 13 in that part designated "Legislative Committees" by striking out all of the 3rd paragraph and inserting in its place the following:

'There shall be no more than 18 Joint Standing Committees which shall be appointed as follows at the commencement of the first regular session, viz:

- On Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry
- On Appropriations and Financial Affairs
- On Audit and Program Review
- On Banking and Insurance
- On Business and Economic Development
- On Criminal Justice
- On Education and Cultural Affairs
- On Human Resources
- On Inland Fisheries and Wildlife
- On Judiciary
- On Labor
- On Legal and Veterans Affairs
- On Marine Resources
- On Natural Resources
- On State and Local Government
- On Taxation
- On Transportation
- On Utilities and Energy'
