2	Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §361-A, sub-§4-A, as enacted by PL 1973, c.
4	450, §3, is amended to read:
6	4-A. Pollutant. "Pollutant" means dredged spoil, solid waste, junk, incinerator residue, sewage, refuse, effluent,
8	garbage, sewage sludge, munitions, chemicals, biological or radiological materials, oil, petroleum products or by-products,
10	heat, wrecked or discarded equipment, reek, sand, dirt and industrial, municipal, domestic, commercial or agricultural
12	wastes of any kind.

18	This bill changes the definition of pollutant in the environmental laws by eliminating rock, sand and dirt.
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
