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Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §11013, sub-§2, ¶K, as enacted by PL 1985, c.
4 702, §2, is amended to read:

Except as otherwise provided for communications location information under section 11011, failure-to-disclose-clearly-in-all-communications-made-to collect-a-debt--er-to-obtain-information-about-a-consumer, that the debt collector is attempting to collect a debt and that - any - information - obtained -will - be - used - for - that - purpose the failure to disclose in the initial written or oral communication with the consumer that the debt collector is attempting to collect a debt and that any information obtained will be used for that purpose, and the failure to disclose in subsequent communications that the communication is from a debt collector, except that this paragraph does not apply to a formal pleading made in connection with a legal action;

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## SUMMARY

The purpose of this bill is to conform Maine's Fair Debt Collection Practices Act to a recent amendment to the federal Fair Debt Collections Practices Act.
