Resolve, to Authorize the Secretary of State to Propose Legislation to Establish Package Stores for the Sale of Alcoholic Beverages.

Reference to the Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs suggested and ordered printed.

Presented by Representative GOODWIN of Pembroke. Cosponsored by Representatives: BUNKER of Kossuth Township, LEMAIRE of Lewiston. Sec. 1. Secretary of State shall establish a package store system. Resolved: That the Secretary of State shall propose legislation to establish a package store system for the purpose of selling liquor, beer and wine in the State. The Secretary of State must include in the proposed legislation the following provisions:

- 1. The annual license fee is \$10,000 and may be resold to another purchaser upon notification to the Secretary of State;
- 2. No limit may be established on the number of stores located in the State;
- 3. Any package store located within an existing facility must be separated by a door and maintain a separate accounting system; and
  - 4. Seventy-five percent of the liquor taxes collected must be paid to the municipality in which the package store is located and 25% must be paid to the Treasurer of State; and be it further
  - Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That the Secretary of State shall report to the Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs the necessary implementing legislation to carry out the purposes of this resolve on or before January 15, 1998.

## SUMMARY

This resolve authorizes the Secretary of State to draft proposed legislation to create a package store system to sell beer, wine and liquor in Maine. The Secretary of State must submit the proposed legislation to the Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs.
