HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 425, L.D. 575, Bill, "An Act to Label All Eggs Produced in the State by Source"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the 2nd indented paragraph after the title the following:

'A retailer may not refuse to purchase eggs solely because any packer's name is on the carton.'

This amendment prohibits a retailer from refusing to buy eggs solely because any packer's name is on the carton.
