Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the 3rd line 24 (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "<u>10</u>" and inserting in its place the following: '<u>9</u>'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in 28 paragraph G in the last line (page 1, line 49 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "<u>; and</u>" and inserting in its place 30 the following: '<u>.</u>'

32 Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 by striking out all of paragraph H (page 1, lines 51 and 52 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the 36 first blocked paragraph in the 2nd line (page 2, line 3 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or E" and inserting in its place 38 the following: 'er, E or G'

40 Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the last blocked paragraph in the first line (page 2, line 11 in
42 L.D.) by striking out the following: "E" and inserting in its place the following: 'E <u>G</u>'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 46 summary the following:

System can be absorbed by the Maine State Retirement System utilizing existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report of the committee. It 8 retains the addition of one of the 2 new voting members to the Board of Trustees of the Maine State Retirement System proposed 10 in the bill, thus increasing the voting members on the board by one to a total of 8. The new trustee must be a member of the 12 retirement system and represent the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 93. The amendment 14 provides that the new member is subject to confirmation by the Legislature and that the new member must have a working knowledge 16 of retirement, banking, finance or investment issues. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
