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SUMMARY

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This bill clarifies that the Department of Human Services must continue to provide the same assistance to legal aliens in this State in the Medicaid, Aid to Families with Dependent Children and related programs that it provided prior to the passage of the federal Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act.
