An Act Relating to the Designation of Species As Endangered or Threatened.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7001, sub-§7, as amended by PL 1995, c. 667, Pt. A, §2, is further amended to read:

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7. Endangered species. "Endangered species" means 6 any species of fish or wildlife that has been determined by the Secretary of the Interior of the United States pursuant to the 8 United States Endangered Species Act of 1973, Public Law 93-205, 10 as amended, or by the commissioner pursuant to chapter 713, subchapter V to be in danger of extinction throughout all or a significant portion of its range and that is -listed as -a -state 12 endangered-species-under-section-7753,-subsection-3.

Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7001, sub-§36, as amended by PL 1995, c. 667, 16 Pt. A, §3, is further amended to read:

18 36. Threatened species. "Threatened species" means anv species of fish or wildlife that has been determined by the 20 Secretary of the Interior of the United States pursuant to the United States Endangered Species Act of 1973, Public Law 93-205, as amended, or by the commissioner pursuant to chapter 713, 22 subchapter V as likely to become an endangered species within the 24 foreseeable future throughout all or a significant portion of its range and-that-is--listed-as--a-state--threatened-species--under section-7753,-subsection-3. 26

Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §7753, sub-§§1 and 2, as amended by PL 1995, c. 415, §2, are further amended to read:

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 **1. Standards.** The commissioner shall recommend <u>designate</u> a
 32 species to be listed as endangered or threatened whenever the commissioner finds one of the following to exist:

- A. The present or threatened destruction, modification or 36 curtailment of its habitat or range;
- 38 B. Overutilization for commercial, sporting, scientific, educational or other purposes;
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- C. Disease or predation;
- D. Inadequacy of existing regulatory mechanisms; or

E. Other natural or manmade factors affecting its continued 46 existence within the State.

48 2. Commissioner's duties. In recommending <u>designating</u> a species to be listed as endangered or threatened, the 50 commissioner shall:

- A. Make use of the best scientific, commercial and other data available;
- B. Consult, as appropriate, with federal agencies, other
  interested state agencies, other states having a common
  interest in the species and interested persons and
  organizations; and
- 10 C. Maintain a list of all species that the Legislature <u>commissioner</u> has designated to be endangered or threatened,
  12 naming each species by both its scientific and common name, if any, and specifying over what portion of its range each
  14 species so designated is endangered or threatened, <u>except</u> that a species may not be added to or deleted from the list
  16 unless notice of the change is published and a public hearing held in accordance with procedures established in section 7035, subsection 1.
- 20 Sec. 4. 12 MRSA §7753, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1995, c. 667, Pt. A, §33, is repealed.

Sec. 5. 12 MRSA 7753, sub- and 5, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 415, 2, are repealed.

## SUMMARY

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This bill gives to the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife instead of to the Legislature the authority to designate wildlife species as endangered or threatened.
