Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 4 MRSA §813 is enacted to read:
§813. Notice of complaint against attorney
The Board of Overseers of the Bar shall have a notice of a
complaint against an attorney and the reason for the complaint
published in a newspaper of general circulation in the area in
which the attorney primarily practices.
SUMMARY
This bill requires the Board of Overseers of the Bar to
publish a notice of a complaint against an attorney in a newspaper in the area in which the attorney primarily practices.
