COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 439, L.D. 589, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Mobile Home Park Laws Regarding Sales of Homes"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 4 in the 1st and 2nd lines (page 1, lines 5 and 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "in order indirectly or directly to profit"

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

The additional workload and administrative costs associated with the minimal number of new cases filed in the court system can be absorbed within the budgeted resources of the Judicial Department. The collection of additional fines may increase General Fund revenue by minor amounts.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment removes the language specifying that interference with the sale of a mobile home is prohibited only if the interference is in order to indirectly or directly profit.
