SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 188, L.D. 606, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Off-track Betting Laws as They Pertain to Reduced Payments for Small Market Licensees"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "January 1, 1995" and inserting in its place the following: 'January-1, 1995 April 1, 1997'

FISCAL NOTE

Changes in the criteria for reduced payments by certain off-track betting facilities may result in a relatively minor loss of dedicated revenue collected by the State Harness Racing Commission.

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the date, from January 1, 1995 to April 1, 1997, by which an off-track betting facility must be licensed in order to qualify for reduced payments.
