HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 193, L.D. 611, Bill, "An Act to Ensure Funding for Snowmobile Law Enforcement Activities"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first and 2nd paragraphs after the title (page 1, lines 22 to 39 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 2, 3 and 4.'

Further amend the amendment in section 7 by striking out all of the first 2 lines (page 1, lines 44 and 45 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

**Sec. 7. Transfer of funds.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the State Controller shall transfer \$24,536 from the carrying balances-inland fisheries and wildlife program in fiscal year 1997-98 and \$24,536 in fiscal year 1998-99 to the Snowmobile Enforcement Fund.

**Sec. 8. Allocation.** The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue to carry out the purposes of this Act.'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment eliminates the loss of General Fund revenues collected by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife and authorizes additional transfers from the Carrying Balance program to the Snowmobile Enforcement Fund of \$24,536 in fiscal year

1997-98 and \$24,536 in fiscal year 1998-99. The Carrying Balance
