HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 193, L.D. 611, Bill, "An Act to Ensure Funding for Snowmobile Law Enforcement Activities"

Amend the amendment by inserting before section 7 the following:

Sec. 6. Transfer of funds. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the State Controller shall transfer an amount equal to the amounts credited pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 7824, subsection 3, paragraph B, subparagraph (1-A) from the carrying balances-inland fisheries and wildlife program in each fiscal year beginning in fiscal year 1997-98 to the General Fund as undedicated revenue.'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment offsets the reductions in General Fund revenues collected by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife by requiring annual additional transfers from the Carrying Balance program to the General Fund undedicated revenue equal to the amount of the revenue dedicated to the Snowmobile Enforcement Fund. The Carrying Balance program has sufficient resources to implement these transfers.
