

10 **Sec. 3. Adjustments to allocations.** Allocations may be increased  
11 or adjusted by the State Budget Officer, with the approval of the  
12 Governor, to specifically cover those adjustments determined  
13 necessary under any salary plan approved by the Legislature and  
14 those reclassifications or range changes that have been approved  
15 by the Department of Administrative and Financial Services and  
16 submitted for legislative review prior to the effective date of  
17 this Act.

18 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the  
19 preamble, this Act takes effect July 1, 1997.
