The commissioner, or the commissioner's designee, shall appear before the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over education and cultural affairs on or before January 31, 2001, to submit a report and any recommendations based on the results of the educational placement options grant program. Funds appropriated to the Department of Education to carry out the purposes of this resolve must be in addition to the customary and ongoing amounts appropriated for general purpose aid to local schools; and be it further
