SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 196, L.D. 624, Bill, "An Act to Expand the Family Medical Leave Laws"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 4 and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 4. Posting of notice. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 26, section 701, the Bureau of Labor Standards is not required to modify and redistribute the printed notice required by that section to reflect the changes in the law resulting from this Act. The Bureau of Labor Standards shall modify the printed notice to reflect the changes contained in this Act when it becomes necessary to print additional notices due to an insufficient supply of those notices or future changes in the law.'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment removes the costs to the Department of Labor.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the appropriation section and exempts the Bureau of Labor Standards from certain poster requirements.
