COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 198, L.D. 626, Bill, "An Act to Provide for Department of Transportation Assistance in the Rehabilitation of Access Roads to Bridges of Historic Significance"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill affects 8.5 miles of roadway accessing 9 bridges of historical significance. The additional cost to the Department of Transportation is estimated at \$37,500 for fiscal year 2000-01. This future funding requirement will be directed to the access road for the wire bridge in the Town of New Portland.'

SUMMARY

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
