20	The Maine Land Use Regulation Commission within the Department of Conservation will require additional General Fund appropriations of \$73,284 and \$79,917 in fiscal years 1997-98 and
22	1998-99, respectively, for 2 additional Environmental Specialist II positions and necessary operating costs for enforcement,
24	rulemaking and the processing of additional permits pertaining to the location, use and construction of hauling roads.
26	
28	The regulation of hauling roads will increase General Fund revenue from permit fees by \$37,500 and \$50,000 in fiscal years 1997-98 and 1998-99, respectively.'
