COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 200, L.D. 628, Bill, "An Act to Authorize the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission to Regulate the Location and Use of Roads in the Unorganized and Deorganized Areas"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 and before the summary the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 200, L.D. 628

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Maine Land Use Regulation Commission within the Department of Conservation will require additional General Fund appropriations of \$73,284 and \$79,917 in fiscal years 1997-98 and 1998-99, respectively, for 2 additional Environmental Specialist II positions and necessary operating costs for enforcement, rulemaking and the processing of additional permits pertaining to the location, use and construction of hauling roads.

The regulation of hauling roads will increase General Fund revenue from permit fees by \$37,500 and \$50,000 in fiscal years 1997-98 and 1998-99, respectively.

SUMMARY

This amendment is the Minority Report. It adds an appropriation section and a fiscal note to the bill.
