A. Having attained the age of 19 years, the person engages in a sexual act with another person, not the actor's spouse, who has attained the age of 14 years but has not attained the age of 16 years, provided that the actor is at least 5 ± 4 years older than the other person; or

SUMMARY

Under current law, a person is guilty of sexual abuse of a minor if, having attained the age of 19, the person engages in a sexual act with another person who is between the ages of 14 and 16, as long as the actor is at least 5 years older than the other person. This bill reduces the age difference between the 2 people from 5 to 4 years.
